During 1982 JOUETT underwent all preparations for deployment and deployed as scheduled on 1 September. The year began with the entire month of January dedicated to an intensive refresher training period, receiving passing scores in all departments. In March the ship passed the critical Nuclear Weapons Acceptance Inspection.

Pre-deployment preparations began in earnest in April, when JOUETT participated in READIEX 3-82, during which time the ship also served as flagship for COMCRUDESGRU ONE. The ship also participated in FLEETEX 1-82 in July, completing exercise requirements prior to forward assignment. COMTHIRDFLT embarked in JOUETT during FLEETEX 1-82.

The ship underwent and passed INSURV in May, but major boiler and main feed pump discrepancies were discovered. Analysis indicated that these discrepancies were resultant from faulty/incomplete work performed by the Long Beach Naval Shipyard during overhaul, and a six week alongside (the pier) effort was necessary to correct the faulty work, considerably compressing the pre-deployment cycle.

As a result, major ship's work continued into the POM period. The ship took and passed OPPE during August and loaded weapons at North Island. Major installations took place in Outboard with the addition of the AN/SSQ-80(V) and the AN/SLR-16A. JOUETT became the first ship in the navy to operate the AN/SLR-16A system.

JOUETT deployed with Battle Group FOXTROT (ENTERPRISE) on 1 September, participating in SHAREM 82 enroute WESTPAC. The ship then took part in historic Battle Force Operations in the Northern Pacific, eliciting an unprecedented Soviet response. During this period JOUETT served as Anti-Air Warfare Commander for the force.

After NORPAC JOUETT chipped to Battle Group ALFA (MIDWAY), serving as Anti-Air Warfare Commander for Battle Group ALFA for the remainder of the year. Significant operations included a four day period in the Andaman Sea, MERLION 83-1, NGFEX 83-2, MISSILEX 83-1B, and Battle Week 83-1. JOUETT entered the royal domain of King Neptune on 27 October, crossing the equator at 106 degrees East.
