

NARRATIVE REPORT

During the first two quarters of 1986, JOUETT was busy jumping through the usual pre-deployment hoops, the first major one being READIEX 86-3. The tempo continued with RIMPAC 86, ammunition loadouts, an ISE period, and several exercises with the USS CARL VINSON (CVN-70).

The third quarter of 1986 began with JOUETT getting underway for its tenth Western Pacific deployment. During this time JOUETT transited to the Northern Pacific to conduct numerous exercises and operations, and participated in a Firepower Demonstration for the Sultan of Brunei who watched the Battle Group's capabilities.

In the last quarter of 1986, JOUETT visited such ports as Singapore, Diego Garcia, Seychelles, and Albany, Australia. Operations in the North Arabian Sea took up most of this time, with Tender Availability being provided by the USS SAMUEL GOMPERS during anchorage off Masirah Island and in port Diego Garcia.
