

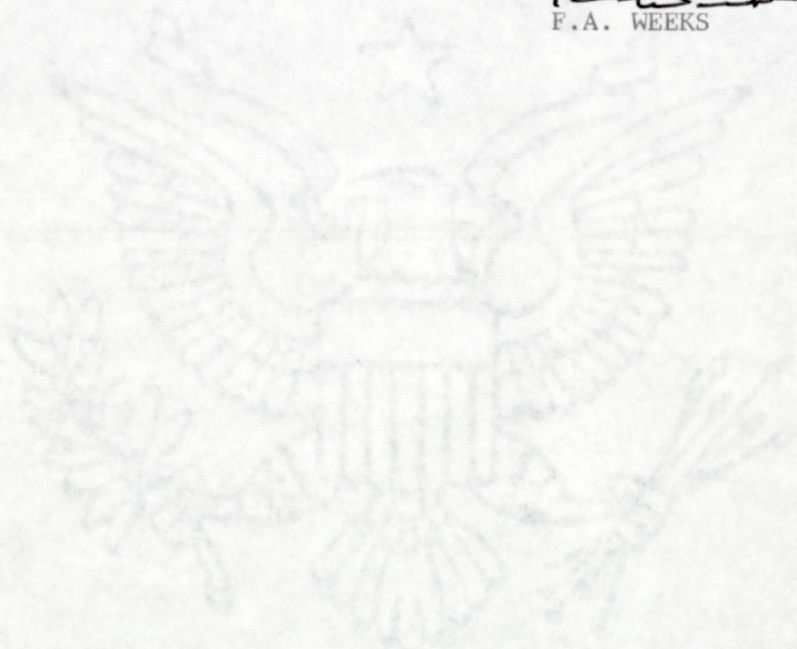

## USS JOUETT (CG 29) 1992 COMMAND HISTORY

### 1. COMMAND COMPOSITION AND ORGANIZATION:

USS JOUETT (CG 29) IS AN ANTI-AIR, ANTI-SURFACE AND ANTI-SUBMARINE WARFARE CRUISER WHICH IN 1992 WAS UNDER THE IMMEDIATE SENIOR COMMAND OF COMMANDER CRUISER DESTROYER GROUP FIVE (COMCRUDESGRU 5) AND COMMANDER CRUISER DESTROYER GROUP ONE (COMCRUDESGRU 1). USS JOUETT IS HOMEPORTED AT SAN DIEGO NAVAL STATION, SAN DIEGO, CALIFORNIA. TRANSITING TO AND FROM WESTPAC, JOUETT EXERCISED OPERATIONAL CONTROL OVER USS DIXON (AS 37), USS PAUL F. FOSTER (DD 964) AND USS FANNING (FF 1076). CAPTAIN F.A. WEEKS WAS COMMANDING OFFICER THE ENTIRE YEAR. ONE H-2 HELICOPTER AIRCRAFT, SEASNAKE 10, WAS ASSIGNED TO JOUETT MANNED BY HSL 33, DETACHMENT NINE, PERSONNEL FROM NAVAL AIR STATION, NORTH ISLAND, SAN DIEGO, CALIFORNIA.

### 3. NARRATIVE

JAN: AWARDED COMMANDER OPERATIONS TEST EVALUATION (COMOPTEVFOR) HOTSHOT AWARD FOR "OUTSTANDING PERFORMANCE DURING THE HARPOON BLOCK ID. USS JOUETT MADE OPEVAL HISTORY BY SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETING FOUR HARPOON MISSILE FIRING EVENTS IN TWO DAYS, 29 AND 31 JAN 92".

-MOBILE TRAINING TEAM (MTT) PHASE II COMPLETED: GRADE GOOD.  
 -FIREX II, NAVAL GUNFIRE SUPPORT (NGFS): RESULT EXCELLENT

FEB: OPERATIONAL PROPULSION PLANT EXAMINATION (OPPE) CONDUCTED WITH INSPECTION BOARD IDENTIFYING NO EQUIPMENT DEGRADED OR OUT OF COMMISSION. THE SHIP'S CLEANLINESS, PRESERVATION, AND STOWAGE WERE EVALUATED AS EXCELLENT. WITH TWO QUALIFIED WATCH SECTIONS AND AN ENGINEERING CASUALTY CONTROL TRAINING TEAM (ECCTT) CAPABLE OF CONDUCTING SELF TRAINING, JOUETT RECEIVED AN OVERALL GRADE OF 87% WITH MOST DRILLS GRADED 92% OR HIGHER.

-OPERATIONAL POWER PLANT EXAMINATION (OPPE) COMPLETED: GRADE EXCELLENT.  
 -COMMUNICATIONS MATERIAL SECURITY (CMS) ASSIST INSPECTION COMPLETED: GRADE EXCELLENT.  
 -COMBAT SYSTEMS READINESS TEST (CSSRT) COMPLETED: GRADE EXCELLENT.  
 -MULTI THREAT TEAM TRAINING K-221-0085 COMPLETED.  
 -ASW TEAM QUALIFICATION PHASE I COMPLETED.

MAR: LAW ENFORCEMENT OPERATIONS (LEO) WITH U.S. COAST GUARD DETACHMENT. JOUETT EXECUTED A RESCUE AT SEA FOR A 26 FOOT MEXICAN FISHING VESSEL THAT WAS DISABLED AND ADRIFT 50 NAUTICAL MILES OFF THE COAST OF MANANILLO, MX.  
 -NAVIGATION CHECK RIDE COMPLETED: GRADE EXCELLENT.

APR: ALL COMERS AT SEA TRAINING (ACAT)--JOUETT FIRED ASROC AND OVER THE SIDE EXERCISE TORPEDOES AGAINST A LIVE TARGET AT CONDITION II-AS; SCORES OF EXCELLENT.

FOSTER (DD 964) AND USS FANNING (FF 1076). DURING TRANSIT IMAGINATIVE EVENTS INVOLVING PUBEXES, NAVAL GUNFIRE AND STEAMING EXERCISES WERE EMPLOYED MAINTAINING THE OPERATIONAL READINESS ACHIEVED ON THE DEPLOYMENT.
