Wednesday Sept. 3rd, 2014 Tour of US Naval Academy

Depart Hotel at 09:00am. Arrive at Naval Academy by 09:30am. for approx. 2hr.+ guided audio -visual presentation and walking tour of the Naval Academy. Highlights include Chapel (when open) and crypt of John Paul Jones, life at the US Naval Academy past and present and various Halls and Monuments. We also plan to hold a brief Remembrance Ceremony at the Columbarium for Captain Robert S Hayes with wreaths being placed at his gravesite and for our Shipmates that have gone before us in the waters of the Severn River adjacent to the site. A visit to the Naval Academy Gift shop is also scheduled before departing the Naval Academy and being bus to downtown Annapolis. Once you arrive downtown everyone will have several hours to explore the sites and history of this town, experience the Maryland style food (Crabs, Crab Cakes etc.) fresh from the Chesapeake Bay and various shops along the cobble stone streets. Trolley and Boat tours are also available. Everyone will board the buses at the designated location at approx. 4:30pm for the ride back to the Hotel.

Thursday Sept. 4th, 2014 Tour of Washington, DC / War Memorials and Arlington Cemetery Depart Hotel at 09:00am. arrive in Washington approx. 10:00am. Bus will drive through areas for photos only and will drop group off at the World War II Memorial and the group will walk to the Vietnam Wall, Korean and to the Lincoln Memorials, where everyone will board the buses for the Iwo Jima Memorial and onto Arlington Cemetery. A guided history tour to last approx. 2hrs. Fort McHenry is the place where the American Flag truly became the symbol of the United States of America.

A replica of the 1814 American flag flies over the Fort 24 hours a day, by Executive order of President Harry S. Truman, as a perpetual symbol of our patriotism, weather permitting - the 1st such Executive ever issued. The Fort is better known for Francis Scott Key's writing of the "Star Spangled Banner" which is the official anthem of the United States since March 3rd, 1931. Depart Fort McHenry at approx. 12:15pm. For Baltimore's Inner Harbor arrive approx. 12:30am. Leisurely tour the various

attractions that align the harbor – The USS Constellation, The National Aquarium, Water Taxis, Maryland Science Center, Maritime Museum, The Inner Harbor Pavilions – Restaurants & Shops. Re-board buses at 4:30pm at designated area. Arrive back at Hotel approx. 5:00pm.
