During 1983 JOUETT completed an eight and a half month deployment to the Western Pacific on 14 May. The year began with JOUETT operating as Anti-Air Warfare Commander for Battle Group Alfa (USS MIDWAY). Significant operations conducted in the Japanese and South Korean regions included MULTIPLEX 83-1, ASWEX 83-13, and Exercise Team Spirit '83.

The ships deployment was extended when JOUETT entered the dry dock in Yokosuka, Japan to replace a damaged Sonar Dome Rubber Window on 26 March. On 28 April, after undocking and Sea Trials, JOUETT began the transit home. First stop was in Pearl Harbor to pick-up fuel, provisions, and numerous "TIGERS". During the Tiger Cruise the ship joined with Destroyer Squadron Seven ships (also returning from WESTPAC) for various demonstrations on shiphandling, fire-power, air capabilities, and other evolutions.

In the time between the post-deployment stand-down and the SRA JOUETT off-loaded her ordnance, successfully passed a Command Inspection by RADM Baldwin, completed a NUCWEP 9024 Training course, underwent an INSURV inspection, and conducted numerous Engineering Casualty Control drills for MTT in preperation for OPPRE.

Lypon completion of the SRA on 6 September, pre-deployment preperations began. Numerous Battle Group meetings and Team Trainers were utilized in preperation for Battle Group Foxtrot's (USS ENTERPRISE) next deployment with JOUETT as Anti-Air Warfare Commander. Time at home was short in supply as the ship participated in a CNO Project along with an Aviation Readiness Evaluation, Naval Gunfire Support Re-qualification, Nuclear Weapons Administration Inspection, Training Readiness Evaluation, Missile Exercise, and ordnance onload.
